Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by payment; forms and fees must be submitted to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the Closing Date. The club will be unable to accept, cancel or alter any entry after the closing date. **Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.** Please make cheques payable to **Calgary English Springer Spaniel Club**. We would encourage all entrants to enter using the www.dogshow.ca website.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds or use the www.dogshow.ca website.

Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. The listing fee is \$10.00 per entry.

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non Member Participation Fee: An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. NOTE: It is less expensive to become a CKC member than to pay this fee each year.

Refund Rules: "Any dog withdrawn because of injury or illness, or for a dog that dies, or a bitch that comes into season shall be refunded in full by the event-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 6, Section 5, Subsection 1*

"The event-giving club is free to formulate its own policy with reference to refunds for other reasons provided that the terms thereof are clearly stated in the premium list." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 6, Section 5, Subsection 2*

Open All-Age Stake: "An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, Section 4*

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the Open Championship Stake, provided that there are 12 or more starters: The winner of the National Open Championship Stake will automatically become a Canadian Open Field Trial Champion and is also entitled to be designated “National Open Spaniel Champion”. 1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points, 3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 12, Section 2*

Indignities: “It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, Section 7*

“It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of or in connection with an event abuses or harasses a judge, trial official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 7, Section 1*

“Any handler who displays unsportsmanlike conduct or who is seen to kick, strike or otherwise roughly manhandle a dog while on the grounds of a Spaniel field trial at any time during the holding of the event, may be expelled from the trial by the Spaniel Field Trial Committee.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 7, Section 2*
