Entry forms and fees must be submitted to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the Closing Date. The club will be unable to accept, cancel or alter any entry after the closing date.

Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. The current listing fee is \$10 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE: An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. NOTE: it is less expensive to become a CKC member than to pay this fee each year!

6.5.1 Any dog withdrawn because of injury or illness, or for a dog that dies, or a bitch that comes into season shall be refunded in full by the event-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate.

6.5.2 The event-giving club is free to formulate its own policy with reference to refunds for other reasons provided that the terms thereof are clearly stated in the premium list.

These events are held under the Rules & Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club:

OPEN ALL-AGE STAKE: “An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4*

POINTS: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the Open Championship Stake, provided that there are 12 or more starters. The winner of the National Open Championship Stake will automatically become a Canadian Open Field Trial Champion and is also entitled to be designated “National Open Spaniel Champion.”

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points,
3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 12, section 2

INDIGNITIES: 21.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, gunner or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

7.1 It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of or in connection with an event abuses or harasses a judge, trial official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

7.2 Any handler who displays unsportsmanlike conduct or who is seen to kick, strike or otherwise roughly manhandle a dog while on the grounds of a Spaniel field trial at any time during the holding of the event, **may be expelled from the trial by the Spaniel Field Trial Committee.**

The consumption of alcoholic beverages on the property is strictly prohibited. No unauthorized motorized vehicles are permitted on the grounds. ATV and UTV will be permitted at the discretion of the Field Trial Committee. Please ensure all cell phones and radios are ‘turned off’ while on line.

Welcome to the 50th Canadian Nationals!

Welcome to the 50th Running of the Canadian National Spaniel field trial. When we decided to take on hosting this wonderful event, we had some long conversations regarding what the event was and what the goal of our team would be. While this might seem obvious to some, it takes only a short time with a few people engaged in conversation to see that there can be many different ideas and concepts of the National. After much conversation, we wrote our Mission statement and published it to read “We as a committee will invest to have the best guns, grounds, courses, planting and judges that are available to us and conduct the National Open in a hospitable and organized fashion to satisfy the needs of the participants”.

With this in hand, we operationalized our efforts. The first steps had actually been taken a few years earlier when we presented to the CNSFTA re the South Western club bid (presentation available online at <http://www.canadianspanielopen.com>). In that proposal, we put forth a format where we had started to establish selection criteria and process for determining judges, guns, grounds, and field trial management personnel. To my knowledge, this is the first time a field trial management group has formalized and published a document of this kind in Canada. We found the act of formalizing our criteria and processes made it possible to ensure we stayed true to our mission. Other benefits were that we communicated more effectively internally and externally, which allowed for engagement of a wider group of talented people (thank you to the many folks from outside the club that helped out). The policy and criteria we used can be found on the first page of the Open website (<http://www.canadianspanielopen.com>) under the heading (Commitment to a Quality National). We owe thanks to the guidance of the AKC blue and green books and their authors as well as the very complete guidance document we received from the CNSFTA through Alice Stewart. We frequently referred to and challenged ourselves to meet our commitment. The transparency of written criteria for selection of guns allowed for this critical task to be done in a manner that all potential candidates could be made aware of the criteria for selection and our field trial committee could objectively evaluate guns throughout the year and subsequently provide the dog handlers with the best. The selection of guns is always, and will always be, an area of discussion; we hope by adding some

formal process to it we have advanced the cause. No process or set of criteria are perfect. In developing our approach to managing this National we hope we have set ground for others to build on and that it will assist in providing the best test for our dogs in an atmosphere of camaraderie and sportsmanship.

We also hope to leave behind a legacy document that will ease the burden on the next host of developing the catalogue and website. We have put time and energy into upgrading the site so that the next club can utilize the existing documents and code and simply switch out the local ads, premium list, judges, guns, etc into the existing structures. We will provide a copydeck, code and structure to facilitate ease of development for the future host clubs to use. It is our hope that this has the added benefit of developing the Open as a consistent and recognizable brand that we and our sponsors are proud of.

A word of thanks to all of the Committee heads and members who worked on the National: thank you for pitching in.

So to the field we go - the most important job ahead: to determine a National champion we can all be proud of. We wish to thank all for their efforts now and in the future as we complete the journey of seeking our 2016 champion. We wish you the best of luck in the competition, and hope that you and your charge compete with vigour and good sportsmanship. We are here to make the event a success for all; please come to us with your feedback and thoughts.

Spaniels have been a part of my life for 66 years. My father purchased my first cocker for me when I reached the age of 4. Good luck to all and have a fun and safe National. All the best – Stan Olszewski

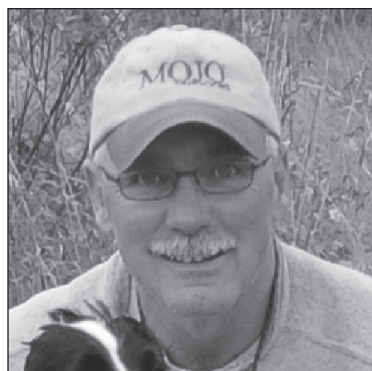


John Meyer

- An article of blaze orange, clearly visible above the waist, **MUST** be worn by all persons in the field at all times.
- All dog's vaccinations must be current.
- To ensure our gunners can take advantage of every shooting opportunity, please park in designated areas only.
- Please follow Marshals and Field Trial Committees instructions for entering and exiting the field. Stay visible at all times and only use laid out entrances and exits.
- Breakfast and lunch services will be available at the trial grounds commencing at 7:00am

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Description of Open All-Age Sporting Spaniel Field Trials

Field Trials are designed to evaluate and compare performances of competing dogs. This consists of efficiently and effectively searching for and finding, then boldly flushing game which has been released ('planted') on the field trial course. The spaniel is expected to do this with desire, eagerness, style and stamina, all the while adjusting its pattern to suit wind conditions and to hunt and produce game within gun range. When game is flushed into the air, the dog must 'hup' (sit), 'mark' the fall of the bird, and retrieve only on command of the handler after the judge has given permission. The dog should retrieve briskly and deliver tenderly to hand. A spaniel must effectively demonstrate not only its natural abilities, but those qualities instilled by training (e.g. control, steadiness and responsiveness).

The course is laid out to provide, as best as possible, each dog with similar cover and equal opportunity to display its hunting ability.

Gunners are experienced and competent handlers of firearms, especially in a trial situation. They 'represent' the handler up to the time that the game is shot. If possible and unless directed by a judge to not shoot at a bird, gunners are supposed to kill cleanly and consistently the game flushed by the spaniel, at a point most advantageous to a fair test of the dog's ability, with due regard for the safety of dogs, handlers, judges, gallery, etc.

A National Open All-Age field trial consists of five land series, and a 'water test'. The first four land series are 'braced': two dogs, each performing under a separate judge, on adjoining 'beats' divided by a line of flags. Each dog must find and flush (or sometimes trap) birds on its beat without interfering with the dog or birds on the other beat, and each must 'honor' the flushed and downed birds of the brace-mate (i.e. stay hupped until commanded to move by the handler, at a time approved by the judge), and must display control under all situations.

In the first series dogs are brought up in rotation (the 'running order' is selected by lot prior to the trial) to appear under the 'left' or 'right' judge and, as each judge completes his assessment on a dog, another is brought 'to the line'. Dogs successfully completing the first series are invited back to the second series on the opposite beat under the other judge. Dogs called back for the 3rd series are brought to the line in numerical order under whichever judge is available. If called back for the 4th series, the dog appears under the other judge. In the 'water test' (after the 4th series in a National), dogs must show an ability to swim and retrieve game from water. Dogs invited back for the final land series (i.e. 5th in a National) run singly and are assessed on individual performance by both judges.

Spaniels completing all land series (and the 'water test') are rated in conference by the judges for overall performance, and placements from first through fourth are decided. Special ribbons ('certificates of merit', i.e. CMs) may be awarded if the judges feel competition for placements has been exceptionally close.

Ribbons/rosettes are awarded as follows: 1st - blue; 2nd - red; 3rd - yellow; 4th - white; CM - dark green. In 'regular' licensed trials (Open All-Age stake; at least eight starters) championship points are: 1st - 5; 2nd - 3; 3rd - 2; 4th - 1. A Field Trial Championship requires at least 10 points, including at least one First and completion of a water test (the 10 points must be earned under at least two different sets of judges). Note that the National winner automatically receives 10 points, and is declared both a Canadian National Field Trial Champion (NFTCh) and a Canadian Field Trial Champion (FTCh).

Faults Which Can Disqualify a Dog:

- 1) **Passed Bird:** The dog does not locate a bird seen (by the judge, that is) to be on the dog's course.
- 2) **Break:** The dog continues running (is not 'steady') after its bird is flushed (takes 'wing') and/or the dog isn't steady to 'shot'.
- 3) **Fails to Honor:** The dog continues hunting when the dog on the other beat flushes a bird (its handler's whistle, the flying bird, and/or a shot at the other dog's bird alerts a dog to honor) or the other dog is in the process of retrieving. (Note: on rare occasions a judge may permit a dog to continue on 'hot pursuit'.)
- 4) **Fails to Retrieve:** The dog fails to retrieve the bird after being commanded to do so by its handler.
- 5) **Out of Control:** The dog does not respond to the handler's commands or it interferes with the dog on the adjacent beat (this includes 'poaching', i.e., flushing or trapping a bird on the other dog's beat).
- 6) **Failed on a Runner:** The dog appears to be tracking a running bird, usually for some distance, but does not produce the bird. This does not automatically lead to disqualification - - the judge has discretion.
- 7) **Hard Mouth:** The dog severely and without reasonable cause damages a bird. The judges must consult, and agree, before this call is made.

More About Judging:

To provide further insight into what a judge may take into account when rating a sporting spaniel, given below is a synopsis of factors which may be considered when filling out a 'judging form'. Please note that this list is only an example, and that a given judge may assign somewhat different degrees of importance (e.g. 'relative point value') to individual factors and/or categories.

Conditions: Terrain, weather, wind, ground cover, temperature, course direction (up, down or cross wind).

Hunting Ability: Pattern, speed and style, aggressiveness, 'nose', flush, use of wind, runner.

Control: Commands, steady, manners.

Honor: Readiness to honor, steady.

Retrieving: Marks fall, pick-up and carry, speed and style, delivery, mouth, cripple (runner), takes direction ('blind'), distance of each retrieve noted.

Water Series: Steady, marks fall, pick-up and carry, speed and style, delivery, mouth.

Birds Handled: Retrieved, picked-up ('trapped'), missed shot number in each category is recorded.

Faults: Passed bird, broke, out of control, failed to retrieve, failed to honor, failed on a runner, hard mouth (each disqualifies the dog).

COMPETITORS – PLEASE NOTE

In order to keep the National running as smoothly as possible, we ask that all Handlers be ‘on the line’ when it is your time to run (please be aware of the progress of each series so you know when you should head out to the field).

NOTES FOR THE GALLERY (SPECTATORS) & COMPETITORS:

We hope you enjoy watching the National. A well-trained spaniel working with its handler makes full use of its natural ability as well as following whistle, hand signal and/or voice commands. Much can be learned about trialing and hunting with spaniels by observation of the trial.

To avoid interfering with the dogs, handlers, judges or gunners, please observe the following requests:

- Follow the marshal’s instructions and keep close behind the marshal.
- Do not string out in a long line, or spread out overly far from the centre line.
- If the gallery has advanced down the field, spectators must NOT travel down or across the field to catch up – rejoin at the start of the course.
- Avoid loud talk, applauding or noise while the dogs are working, as it could disturb the birds or dogs.
- Children are welcome, but please keep them within the gallery at all times.
- Noncompeting dogs must not be in the grounds (except in the parking area where they must be leashed when not kenneled).

REQUIREMENT IN CANADA FOR WEARING OF BLAZE ORANGE

EVERYONE who is out on the Trail Grounds **MUST** wear an article of **blaze orange** in colour and of “reasonable size” somewhere on their attire **above waist level**.

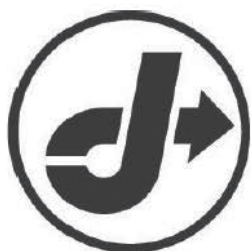

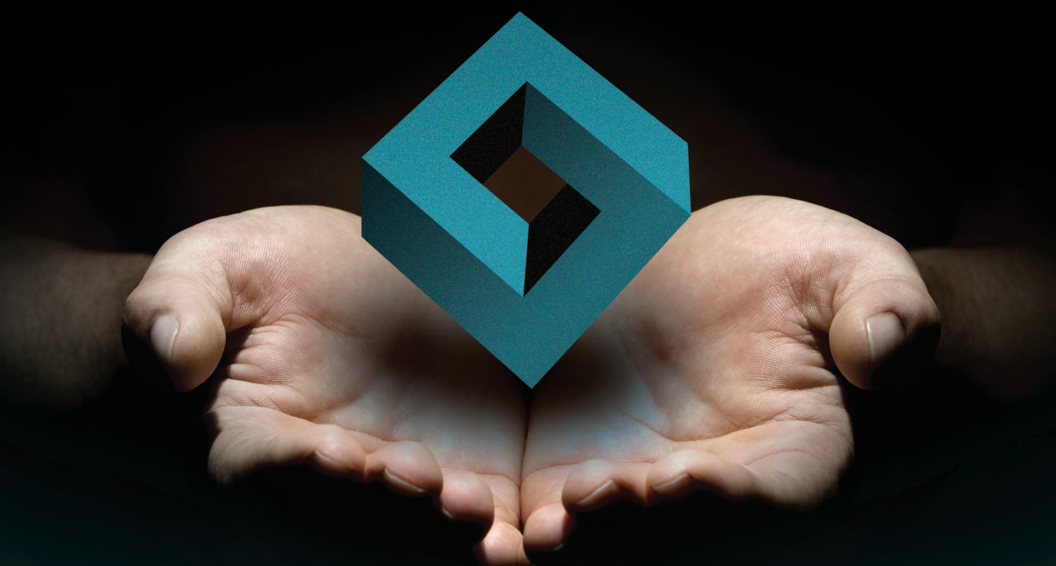

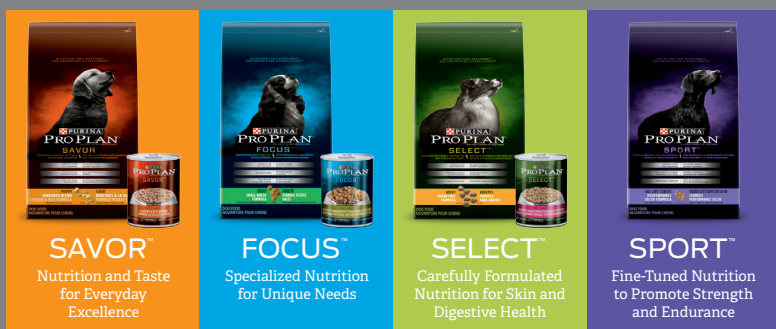
