**National Amateur Champion:** The winner of the National Amateur Championship Stake will automatically become an Amateur Field Trial Champion (AFTCh) and is also entitled to be designated “National Amateur Spaniel Champion” (NASC). *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Section 12.1.2.*

**Eligibility:** The dog declared the winner of the last National Amateur Championship Stake shall be invited to compete in the stake. Pursuant to this regulation and until otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club, entry of dogs in this stake shall be confined to the following: (a) A dog which has placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in an Amateur All Age Stake (including a previous Amateur National) at a CKC approved trial held under these rules hosted by a member club in good standing with the Canadian National Spaniel Field Trial Association (CNSFTA) will be qualified for the following 2 National Amateur Championship Stakes. (b) All dogs which have previously won this Stake . *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Section 12.1.4.*

**National Amateur Stake:** The National stakes must have at least 6 series, 5 on land and one in water. The dogs should run in pairs for at least 4 land series, but it is required that each dog competing must be paired with another dog in at least 2 of these series; in all 4 if possible. In no event may a dog not under judgement be used to create a pair. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Section 12.5.1.*

**Amateur All-Age:** An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Section 10.5.*

**Water Test** - A Spaniel is primarily a land dog. However, in many parts of the country he is used to retrieve waterfowl, and in an ordinary day's shoot there are occasions when the only way of gathering shot game is after a swim or from a stream, pond or lake. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Section 16.3.5*

**Points:** Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 12 or more starters. An all-age placement qualifies the dog to enter in the next two corresponding national field trial events: Points awarded as follows:

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points, 3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

## **AWARDS**

Standard CKC Rosettes and keeper plaques for all placing dogs. Perpetual trophy and plaque for the winner.

**Field Apparel:** **Blaze Orange** visible above the waist is required by anyone that will be on the field while a trial is in progress. **NOTE:** Alcohol not permitted on the trial grounds.

**Indignities and Unsportsmanlike Conduct:**  
**CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations:**

**21.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, gunner or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair **shall** promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

**7.1** It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of or in connection with an event abuses or harasses a judge, trial official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

**7.2** Any handler who displays unsportsmanlike conduct or who is seen to kick, strike or otherwise roughly manhandle a dog while on the grounds of a Spaniel field trial at any time during the holding of the event, **may be expelled from the trial by the Spaniel Field Trial Committee.**

**Non-member participation fee**

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

**Attention US Handlers:** Entry and payment through <http://cnsfta.com/> is preferred to give you full value of your dollar. Otherwise, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry.
